Specific Responsibilities

- To take responsibility of planning and delivering daily English and Maths lessons to groups of children (approx. 15 per group, and including children who require additional support) in Upper KS2, to a high standard.
- To meet all national Teacher Standards and school career stage expectations
- To liaise with the respective class teachers in terms of pupil attainment and progress and report on achievements at various stages in the year (including termly parents' evenings end of year reporting to parents)
- To assist colleagues, to ensure consistent high standards relating to pupil outcomes, behaviour and assessment, and adhering to the expectations as referenced in the Staff Handbook
- To ensure that learning objectives are identified and tailored to the needs of the individual.
- To assess and record pupil's progress and attainment ensuring personal growth and enjoyment.
- To analyse pupil data, predict likely attainment, set targets and produce the necessary reports as necessary.
- To direct the work of teaching assistants where relevant.
- To liaise with SEND Co-ordinator (SENCO) as appropriate.
- To contribute to writing reports for children with SEND and/or EHCPs in consultation with SENCO.
- To report to parents both orally and in writing
- To offer equal opportunities to all pupils
- To provide pastoral care for the children of each class
- To promote good behaviour and encourage self-discipline by observing the relevant school policies
- To encourage a purposeful, working atmosphere in all classes
- To inform and liaise with parents as appropriate
- To attend courses as required and keep abreast of current educational thinking
- To support the school in implementing all school policies
- To ensure 'Best Value' in the procurement of resources
- To contribute to the collective responsibility relating to the safeguarding and welfare of pupils
